STUDY VISIT TO GAS DISTRICT COOLING PLANT 3

The Study Visit to Gas District Cooling (GDC) Putrajaya Plant 3 hosted by GDC (Putrajaya) Sdn Bhd was organised on 7th February 2018. The study visit was

held with the aim to create awareness and enhance our members' knowledge on gas district cooling. MBAM Treasurer General and Chairman of Mechanical & Electrical (M&E) Committee, Mr Kenneth Liew led a team of 12 MBAM members for the visit. MBAM Deputy Chairman of M&E Committee, Mr Chong Tat Yam, M&E Committee Members, Mr Lee Ah Nam and Mr Gan Wah Lien were also present for the visit.

Plant 3 is located in Precint 5 Putrajaya. It was built in 2008 and has 7,200 RT chilled water output. The plant are set up with 5 direct fired chiller and 1 electrical chiller. At the end of the visit, Mr Kenneth Liew presented a token of appreciation to Ir. Ahmad. Overall, the participants gave feedbacks that they were satisfied with the visit as it was educational and have added to their knowledge on gas district cooling system.

MBAM President, Mr Foo Chek Lee in his opening speech thanked Port Dickson Builders for the invitation. He then gave

a short briefing on the Malaysian economy which is expected to maintain a 5.5% growth, supported by the many government projects such as the East Coast Rail Line, MRT Line 2 and 3, Pan Borneo Highway and numerous Perumahan Rakyat projects. He projected that construction projects will achieve RM180 billion in year 2018.

He highlighted that despite such rosy outlook, there are many challenges facing the industry such as issues of levy of foreign workers borne by employers, as well as requirements of accreditation for all skilled workers and supervisors. Mr Foo cautioned that there are penalties for failure to adhere to it. He urged all contractors to quickly apply for accreditation for their workers and supervisors and seize the current offer of reduced fees charged by CIDB. Other issues touched by Mr Foo were on the proposed adjustment of the minimum

wage which would increase the cost of doing business. He said that MBAM has been engaging the government on this issue. He also invited all present to participate in the IBS Seminar 2018 which will be organised by CIDB and MBAM on 28th March 2018 in conjunction with the MIIE'18.

To commemorate the occasion, an exchange of memento was performed by MBAM President and President Port Dickson Builders Association, witnessed by me.

INTERVIEW WITH FOCUS MALAYSIA

The Focus Malaysia writer, Ms Sonia Ramachandran paid a visit to MBAM to interview MBAM President, Mr Foo Chek Lee on 13th February 2018 at the President's room. The interview revolved around the labour issues. To recap, the E-Card (enforcement card) programme for unregistered foreign workers ended on 30th June last year and

the rehiring programme ended six months after that. At present, employers have to pay almost double to bring in legal foreign workers after absorbing all fees for recruiting the foreign workers.

In addition, the property sector are also facing a slowdown due to slow sales and stringent lending requirements. The construction fraternity are worried that these problem will lead to higher costs of doing business which will have a ripple effect to the consumer such as increase of property prices. It is important that the authority to set up a special council that consists of Government and industry players to look into the problems related to the industry and to come up with a solution that benefits both parties.

46TH BUILDING INDUSTRY PRESIDENTS' COUNCIL (BIPC) MEETING

MBAM President, Mr Foo Chek Lee, MBAM Executive Director, Ms Loh Mei Ling and I attended the 46th Building Industry Presidents' Council Meeting held on 26th February 2018 at Wisma Real Estate Housing and Developers' Association, Malaysia (REHDA) Conference Room, Kelana Jaya, Petaling Jaya.

Dato' Mohamed Mansur to Master Builders Association Malaysia (MBAM), Mr Foo Chek Lee effective from 26th February 2018.

Some of the issues and matters discussed were as follows:-

- (i) Update on the Safeguard duties on rebar, steel wire rods and deformed bar in coils import – the duties will drop from 13.42% to 12.27% with effect from 14th April 2018.
- (ii) The Government has imposed anti-dumping duties on cold-rolled stainless steel in coils imported from The People's Republic of China, The Republic of Korea, Chinese Taipei and the Kingdom of Thailand steel manufacturers with effect from 8th February 2018 at various rates for a period of 5 years ending on 7th February 2023.
- (iii) Update on the CIDB Interview Sessions for Site Supervisor Accreditation With effect from 1st February 2018 to 31st July 2018, CIDB Malaysia will be having a promotion rate at RM100.00 instead of RM200.00 per person for the each interview session. And for accreditation of skill worker (foreign worker) will be charged at RM270.00 per person instead of RM450.00. Accreditation of local workers are free of charge.
- (iv) CIDB has completed the Construction Industry Standard (CIS) 22 for Scaffolding in November 2017 and is now at the final stage of producing the CIS 23 for Falsework.

The proposal was to establish a special Manpower Council that should comprise of representatives from the Government, industry players and trade unions for both labour employer / employee to formulate national policies which include the hiring of local and foreign workers.
