BIZ EDGE INTERVIEW WITH MBAM & SWAM ON SAFEGUARDS INVESTIGATION ON STEEL WIRE IMPORT

MBAM President, Mr Foo Chek Lee was invited for an informal interview with Mr Jose Barrock from The Edge and the President of Steel Wire Association of Malaysia, Mr Ernest Koay at Chili's Grill & Bar Restaurant, Paradigm Mall on 15th March 2017. During the lunch meeting they discussed several issues on steel that led to MBAM's opposition against safeguard measures on steel products, as they fear prices of steel bars may be uncontrollable without free flow of import.

local producers are not supposed to be protected despite their inability to be competitive even when the Government had provided the industry with numerous protection measures.

MBAM has also highlighted that the price of steel bars has increased from about RM1,500 per tonne in January 2016 to a record high of RM2,500 per tonne. MBAM believes that the sudden rise in steel prices over such a short period is not justified. MBAM believes the Government should look at a sustainable long term plan on this issue, as the

THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 6 PRACTICAL CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION / MANAGEMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME

The 2nd session of the 6 Practical Construction Contract Administration/Management training programme took place on 22nd March 2017 at MBAM Training Centre. There were 47 participants who had attended this session. In the opening speech delivered by MBAM Executive Director, Ms Loh Mei Ling, she thanked Sr. Ong for agreeing to hold this seminar for the 3rd year after we started with the first 6 Sessions of Practical Construction Contract Administration/Management back in 2015.

Construction contracts generally allow the construction period to be extended when there is a delay that is not the contractor's fault. When it becomes reasonably apparent that there is a delay, or that there is likely to be a delay that could merit an extension of time, the contractor gives written notice to the contract administrator identifying the relevant event that has caused the delay. If the contract administrator accepts that the delay was caused by a relevant event, then they may grant an extension of time and the completion date is adjusted. However, things may not be so straight forward. This is described as an Extension of Time (EOT) which is an interesting topic being shared with MBAM members in the second session of this training programme.
