# Study Visit To myBIM Centre Sunway Putra Tower, Kuala Lumpur Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2017

## BACKGROUND

On 20 November 2017, the Construction Industry Development Board Malaysia (CIDB) has officially launched the RM2.5 million myBIM Centre at Sunway Putra Tower. This centre is operated by CIDB E-Construct Services Sdn Bhd (CIDBEC).

CIDBEC was integrated in Malaysia on February 21, 2001, as a result of a joint-venture agreement between the Construction Industry Development Board Malaysia (CIDB) and Malaysian Institute of Microelectronic Systems (MIMOS). Thereafter, CIDB assimilated all of MIMOS's shares in this association pact making CIDBEC a wholly-owned division of CIDB.
