BRIEFING BY DIRECTOR-GENERAL OF DOSH ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE OSH ACT 1994

During The Briefing Session

The Occupational Safety and Health in Construction Industry (Management) 2017 (OSHCIM) developed by Department of Occupational Safety and Health Malaysia (DOSH) was based on the principle of prevention through design where safety element will be taken into consideration at all stages of construction projects involving the client, designer and contractor on the management of safety, health and welfare.

DOSH is committed in adopting OSHCIM and the proposed amendment for OSHA to replace the BOWEC Regulations under the Factories Machinery Act (FMA) will be tabled in the Parliament for approval in May 2019. The OSHCIM Guideline will be made mandatory and the client/project owners, designers and contractors will be playing equal roles and responsibilities in managing any OSH risks in a construction project.

Therefore, DOSH Director-General, Tuan Ir Hj Omar Bin Mat Piah scheduled a briefing session to MBAM and Persatuan Kontraktor Bumiputera Malaysia (PKBM) members on the proposed amendment. The briefing on 2 April at MBAM Training Centre attracted 101 participants. MBAM President, Foo Chek Lee; Chairman of Safety and Health Committee, Michael Yap with his committee members, Datuk Kow Choong Ming, Chong Tat Yam and Nalla Sundran; MBAM Council Members and Members were also present. Represented PKBM were Datuk Haji Azman Yusoff, Dato' Ir Jamaludin Non, Ir Zainizam Mat Zain and Sr Asmuni Sajat.

Chairman of OSHCIM Advisory Committee, Tan Sri Dato' (Dr) Ir Jamilus Bin Hussein gave an introductory speech on OSHCIM and followed by sharing from Tuan Ir Hj Omar and Ir Dr Mohd Fairuz Ab Rahman from DOSH Malaysia on OSHCIM implementation.

OSHCIM Committee Members, Ir M. Ramuseren and Maj (R) Ir Haji Kamarulzaman Bin Hj Musa also attended the briefing session together with other DOSH officers.

PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT SERVICES CONFERENCE

The Public Employment Services Conference was held on 15 April at Aloft Hotel, Kuala Lumpur and was attended by MBAM Secretariat staff, Tan Lee Teng and Sung Suet Yee.

The conference started with a presentation by the Chief Executive Officer of SOCSO, Dato' Sri Dr Mohammad Azman where he highlighted the importance of EIS and how SOCSO helped insured persons. He also introduced the Public Employment Services (PES) to the audience and emphasised the importance of PES.

The second speaker was VDAB Belgium's Chief Executive Officer, Fons Leroy who spoke on the roles and objectives as well as challenges of PES.

The third speaker was WCC Netherlands's Chief Executive Officer, Jan Jensen who gave a brief introduction on WCC and its background. During his talk, he made comparison between the role of PES with the role of other staffing agencies, and their job portals. He also talked about the challenges faced by different stakeholders in PES and how technology can help them, citing example of the technology used by WCC.

REVIEW ON CIDB ACT 520 FOURTH SCHEDULE

The above workshop was attended by MBAM Material Resources Committee Member, Tony Foo together with MBAM Secretariat staff, Michael Thong and Leon Leong.

The Chairman, Tuan Haji Sazali Che Amat, CIDB General Manager, welcomed the participants to the meeting and briefed on the objectives of the meeting which was to review the CIDB Fourth Schedule and to streamline the construction materials in the Act by either omit, add or update. In addition, the key performance index was to add in five new construction materials into the Act 520 Fourth Schedule by year end 2020. Construction materials were now classified under a "risk factors index matrix" which categorised as high risk and low risk weighted against the test impact and safety impact.

With the above guidelines given, participants were divided into five working groups to deliberate the given construction materials for each group. In summing up the workshop, the Chairman informed that all the recommendations would be further evaluated, fine-tuned and published for public comments after which a final decision would be made. Ultimately, he hoped that the end result would be a self-regulation by the industry itself on the usage of safe and quality construction materials.

FMM — MPOB SEMINAR ON BIODIESEL (B7) IMPLEMENTATION IN INDUSTRIAL SECTOR

Seminar on Biodiesel (B7) Implementation in Industrial Sector was held on 26 April. Welcome remarks by FMM President, Dato' Soh Thian Lai was followed by a speech delivered by the Guest of Honour, Minister of Primary Industries, YB Puan Teresa Kok. Biodiesel (B7) use for all industrial applications will be made mandatory effective on 1 July 2019. When it was announced by Minister of Primary Industries in November 2018, the objectives are to use more local product and make use of palm oil as one of the resources.

According to YB Teresa Kok, there is a RM 5 Billion insurance taken up for faulty engines during the implementation of B7 for industrial machineries consumption. The government seek the co-operation from all industries to support as the consumption of palm oil will be increased from time to time in the future. Seminar on biodiesel included an overview of biodiesel industry in Malaysia, implementation mandates and procedures for exemption, sharing of experience by three companies namely, Sime Darby Oils Biodiesel Sdn Bhd, ExcelVite Sdn Bhd and FGV Biotechnologies Sdn Bhd.

The seminar was attended by MBAM Secretariat, Lee Siew Mei, Mohd Farhan Bin Mohammad Din and Muhammad Fadzley Bin Salim.
