Under the requirement of the Occupational Safety and Health (Construction Work)(Design & Management) Regulations 2024, Regulation 8(1), also known as CDM Regulation 2024, If the construction work at the construction site is scheduled to run for more than thirty working days or exceeds five hundred man-days, the client shall notify the Director General in writing as soon as practicable before the construction phase begins. Any client who violates this regulation could be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand ringgit or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or to both. Thus, all relevant construction sites must be registered before commencement of physical works. The registration process will begin with the project client, followed by consultant, main contractor and sub-contractor. They are required to complete the Pemberitahuan JKKP12 via MyKKP portal for the following:

- (i) Pemberitahuan Projek
- (ii) Pemberitahuan Tapak Pembinaan
- (iii) Pengaktifan Tapak Pembinaan

This Seminar will provide participants with a detailed, step-by-step guide to the registration process and highlight common technical issues that companies often encounter when completing the online registration.

The seminar will be held in a hybrid format, with IN-PERSON attendance at the MBAM Training Hall and simultaneous online participation.
