

Master Builders Association Malaysia Education Fund Scholarship Application Guidelines

Courses of study

- Recognised Local university (Public & Private) in construction related courses for example civil engineering, mechanical & electrical engineering, quantity surveying, construction management, information technologies and computer science

Application Period

- Full time study
- Application is opened from 1 May 2026 till 15 June 2026.
- Application will close at 1730 hours on 15 June 2026.

Eligibility & Requirements

- Malaysian citizen below 35 years of age as of 1 January of intake for year of intake for first level of tertiary education leading to a bachelor degree or professional qualification in local/private university.
- An excellent academic track record and active in sport and extracurricular activities.
- A strong ability to communicate your thoughts.
- Must show proof of financial need.
- Undergo internship for the entire duration of industrial training with MBAM members.
- Must not be bonded to or in receipt of any financial assistance or rewards from other educational institutions or organization or foundations.
- Already accepted or is expecting to receive an offer from university to pursue construction related courses. Current university students are also eligible to apply provided the courses pursued are related to construction.
- Applicant must have secured a letter of offer from the university.
- Applicant must submit a personal statement that includes the reasons of your application, your personal aspirations, career and ambition. It must not be more than two (2) A4 size page.
- All requisite documents mentioned in the application form must be certified prior to submission or else it will be deemed to be incomplete and may not be considered.
- The scholarships is up to RM10,000.00 annually and is without bond.
- All applications and required documents are to be emailed to ed@mbam.org.my and thereafter send all these documents by post to the address in the application form.
- Application by post must reach MBAM office on or before 15 June 2026 by 1730 hours.
- Late application will not be considered.

Others

- Only shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview session.
- Successful applicants will be notified within two (2) weeks or such other duration as may be determined by the Board of Management after the interview session.
